
Committed Teachers and Caring Parents

Parent involvement is outstanding and is a hallmark of the district. Strong parental support is manifested at orientations, open house programs, conference sessions and student performances. At the high school, booster clubs in athletics and music provide exemplary support for program enrichment. At the elementary schools, the PTAs have provided financial commitment for a variety of programs including an on site writer-in-residence and a school weather station.

Aggressive Technology

All schools maintain up-to-date computer labs as well as portable computer labs. All schools are fully wired and contain classroom computers. A wide area network connects all school buildings and gives students and staff access to the Internet. Students serve as technology assistants and a television studio has started in operation. Staff technology training groups use portable computers and teacher technology benchmarks as training guides.

717 students, 9-12

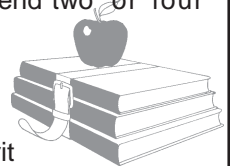
The schools are well regarded and continue to pursue their primary goal of improving student learning and achievement at all levels.

Growing Community

Regional School District No. 10 is comprised of the towns of Burlington and Harwinton. They are lovely rural, suburban towns located in the Litchfield Hills and the Farmington Valley in northwestern Connecticut. While they presently have a combined population of about 13,600, the region continues to grow. Burlington was named "the fastest growing town in Connecticut" in a recent Hartford newspaper article. In an issue of Connecticut Magazine, Harwinton was listed as the third most desirable Connecticut town with a population under 10,000. The communities' dedication to children and the desire to provide quality educational programs make this an excellent place to live and work. The student population is projected to grow to 3,000 in the next ten years.

The towns are located within close proximity to the educational, cultural and business opportunities afforded by the cities of Hartford, Waterbury and Torrington. In addition, extensive park and recreational facilities are located in the towns of Burlington and Harwinton.

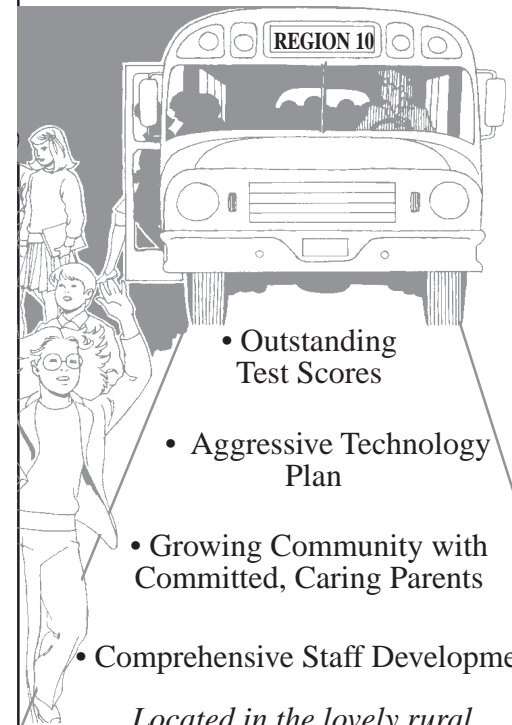
