Welcome to Honors Geometry with Mrs. Barlowski!!

The following is an outline of the classroom procedures, student expectations, and guidelines for Honors Geometry. It will provide you with important information to help you achieve the greatest amount of success throughout the school year. Please read this document carefully.

CLASS PREPARATION:

- 1.) Be on time to class and seated by the time the bell rings. The school policy for absences and tardies will be strictly enforced.
- 2.) Be prepared for every class. Students should bring the following with them to class every day:
 - **Notebook** with paper
 - Writing implements
 - Textbook
 - TI Graphing Calculator
 - Any work previously assigned

GRADING POLICY: The grades for this class will be determined based on the following:

Tests: Announced tests will be given at the end of each chapter. Some time will be spent reviewing in class on a day prior to the test, but if students need more help, they will be responsible for making arrangements. Tests are generally worth 80 - 100 points.

- 1.) Homework/Classwork: Occasionally, students will be given assignments that will need to be completed during class. These assignments will be collected and scored based upon completeness and accuracy. Additionally, homework will be given on a daily basis. Homework assignments will be worth 3 points, and late homework will not be accepted.
- 2.) Quizzes: Quizzes will be given on a regular basis to assess students' progress and comprehension. Not all quizzes will be announced. Quizzes are worth 30-50 points.
- 3.) Projects: Projects will be assigned, and are worth 30-50 points.
- 4.) Notebook: NOTEBOOKS ARE REQUIRED and will be used by the students to organize their work. Students are expected to take notes daily and to store all returned homework, quizzes, tests, and worksheets. Occasional quizzes will be given requiring the use of the notebook.
