

ACADEMIC INTERVENTION PROGRAM FOR STUDENT ATHLETES:

Applies for the following trigger points based on weighted GPA generated by Power School:

**<2.0 Academic Probation
<1.5 Academic Modification**

NOTE: GPA's will be checked on the schedule found on page 2 of this document: Official school progress report date, issue date of report cards and the midpoints between official progress report and report card issue dates. **Changes to Academic Status will only occur on these dates.**

Academic Probation:

Student-Athletes will be required to provide weekly progress reports to the head coach, signed by each teacher on Friday of each week. Students will be removed from Academic Probation when their current GPA improves above a 2.0 at a subsequent progress check date.

Each week, the student will be required to attend **2** days of homework club. Homework club meets daily in Room 101 (Computer Lab across from the Main Office). A signed Athletic Intervention pass will be turned into the head coach after each homework club attended as proof of attendance.

Failure to turn in progress reports or signed intervention passes from homework club will result in a one game suspension for the next scheduled contest.

Academic Modification:

Students in Academic Modification may still attend practices with coach's permission (after attending the required Homework Club, extra help, etc.).

Student-Athletes will be required to provide weekly progress reports to the head coach, signed by each teacher on Friday of each week. Students will be promoted from Academic Modification when their current GPA improves above a 2.0 at a subsequent progress check date.

Each week, the student will be required to attend **3** days of homework club. A signed Athletic Intervention pass will be turned into the head coach after each homework club attended.

Failure to turn in progress reports or signed intervention passes from homework club will result in a one game suspension for the next scheduled contest.

Administration of Program:

On the specified target dates, the Coordinator of Athletics will generate the academic report and forward the team marks to the head coaches. He will also notify them of any students falling under Academic Intervention. A student-athlete tracking sheet will be sent to the head coach for recording purposes. The head coach and/or the Coordinator of Athletics will meet with the student to review the grade report and the requirements for the Academic Intervention Program. The head coach and/or the Coordinator of Athletics will also notify the parent. The student-athlete will immediately begin in the program. If the current week is not a full week, the Coordinator of Athletics will make any necessary modifications to the program.

The student-athlete will be responsible for follow through on turning in the progress report and intervention passes to the head coach. When the student successfully moves out of the Academic Intervention Plan, all paperwork will be turned into the Coordinator of Athletics.
