CONSIDERATION OF CONFIDENTIAL STUDENT MATTER

A **motion** to adjourn to executive session for the purpose of conducting an expulsion hearing for student 052218 during which matters of personal privacy of one or more students enrolled in Region 10 Schools are likely to be discussed, by name, and during which educational records not subject to disclosure under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act are likely to be discussed and to invite Mr. Alan Beitman, Superintendent of Schools; Mr. Christopher Rau, Campus Principal, Lewis S. Mills High School; the mother and the student into the hearing was made by Eleanor Parente and seconded by John Vecchitto at 6:32 pm; all in favor; none opposed; motion carried unanimously.

Board Motion

Eleanor Parente made a motion that the Board of Education adopt the stipulation agreement submitted by the parties regarding all issues of fact, with the noted amendments, and to expel the student, who was subject of the expulsion hearing in accordance with the terms and conditions recommended by the parties, seconded by John Vecchitto.

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Amendments:


- Provided for the opportunity to return early at the beginning of the 2018/2019 school year and to be allowed to participate in pre-season activities;
- As part of the conditions for early return, the student will complete 200 hours of meaningful community service approved by the campus principal, 150 of which must be completed at the commencement of the pre-season activities and the balance of which must be completed by October 29, 2018.

All in favor; none opposed; motion carried unanimously.


ADJOURN
