Instruction

Care of Instructional Materials/Outstanding Debts

Damaged/Lost Instructional Materials/Outstanding Lunch Charges

The Board of Education may impose sanctions against students who lose or damage textbooks, library books, other educational materials, or have outstanding lunch charges. The Superintendent is authorized by the Board to withhold grades, transcripts and/or report cards until the student pays for the instructional material, returns the item(s) in good condition, and/or pays their outstanding lunch fees.

Students will not be held responsible for normal wear and tear of instructional materials. The age and developmental level of the student will be taken into consideration in determining whether sanctions are appropriate.

Students and parents/guardians will be notified in writing when a student is subject to sanctions for damaged or lost instructional materials or fails to pay for their lunch fees.
